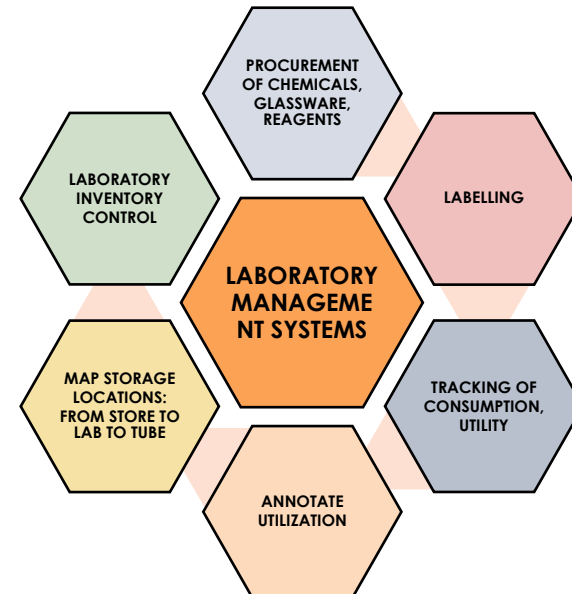

Objectives

It is observed that laboratory technicians, research students and faculty are adroit in using sophisticated instruments, but not trained adequately for handling repair and maintenance issues which crop up during the usage of the same. Several machines lie unused due to lack of funds required for maintenance. This also brings the research activities to a halt.

The objectives of this workshop are::

1. Providing sound theoretical background on the operational aspects of small frequently used machines in our laboratories and repair issues that can be addressed by laboratory staff by providing on-the-job training.
2. Safety measures that can be adopted to prevent mishaps during working in the laboratories.
3. Training for immediate First-aid measures in case of burns, cuts, wounds, chemical exposure (internal and external).
4. Quality management systems that can be adopted in accordance with WHO/ ISO guidelines.
