The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) meeting was held this month on August 12, 2017 at 12.30 pm. The IQAC of the college comprises of members encompassing representatives of management, faculty, industry, administration, alumni and students. The primary aim of IQAC is:

- To develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.
- To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

The meeting was held with the following agenda:

- a) Ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks;
- b) Relevance and quality of academic and research programmes;
- c) Application of ICT in teaching – learning process;
- d) Sharing of research findings and networking with other institutions in India and abroad.

The meeting began with the presentation of college report and activities in the AY 2016-17 by Dr. Munira Momin, Principal and Chairperson of IQAC. The committee reviewed the strengths and weaknesses of the college and gave inputs on ways to improve and transform weakness into strengths.

The following suggestions and inputs were given by the members:

#### **Institute**

- Hands on workshop to be organized in the areas of molecular biology, Western Blot techniques for inhouse faculty and faculty from other institutes.
- Initiation of focus group of fast learners to create University rank holders.

#### **Students**

- Organizing undergraduate industrial and hospital visits to be intensified.
- Mentorship process and deliverables to be streamlined and strengthened.
- Skill development courses to be explored for undergraduate and postgraduate students to strengthen the teaching learning process and widen their skill set
- Exposure to alternate career options by eminent industrialists to be initiated.

#### **Faculty**

- Skill development courses to be explored for the faculty and postgraduate students to strengthen the teaching learning process and widen their skill set.
